- CAPF 31: Application for Encampment or Special Activity
- CAPF 160: CAP Member Health History Form
- CAPF 161: Emergency Information (**2 copies**)
- CAPF 163: Permission for Provision of Minor Cadet OTC Medication
- SQTR Training Worksheet

Items to bring:

- Sack Lunch and some snacks
- Water- Camel Back preferred or canteen
- Sunglasses and/or safety glasses
- Ear plugs (recommended)
- Sunscreen, minimum PF30
- Warm coat and/or rain gear, if cold weather

REMINDER: your Squadron Commander will ALWAYS need to approve your request for FLM training.

Pre-Requisites:

1. Get Commander's Approval on your SQTR enter the date
2. General Emergency Services (101 Card) Follow the chain of command for getting information on how to complete GES. You must have earned your Curry Achievement to get GES status. DO NOT WAIT until the last minute to do this. If you do not have your GES, you will not be allowed to participate. Here are the required on-line exams for earning GES, located in "E-Services On-Line Exams"
 - a. CAPT 116 pt 1 (General ES)
 - b. OPSEC

6. CAPT 117 pt 2 (Emergency Services)
7. Aircraft Handling Video
9. Basic Safety On-line Course in e-services
10. Current Safety Briefing with your squadron
11. Introductory Communications User Training in e-services

Driving directions to the Arlington Airport Office:

- Take exit 206 off of Interstate 5 (Smokey Point exit)
- Head East off the exit (172nd ST NE / Hwy 531)
- Turn left on 59th Ave NE
- The airport office will be on your left (18204 59th Dr. NE)

Driving directions to the EAA/Fly-In Hanger:

- Take exit 206 off of Interstate 5 (Smokey Point exit)
- Head East off the exit (172nd ST NE / Hwy 531)
- Turn left on Smoke Point Blvd (Intersection with Rite-Aid/Arco/7-11)
- Turn right on 188th ST NE
- Follow 188th to the Arlington Airpark entrance (The road makes a sharp left at the yellow blinking light. DO NOT follow the road around the corner. Drive straight into the airport/ultralight park entrance.
- The blue fly-in hanger will be first on the right.
